

Discussion session on Interview preparation for the UPSC:

The foremost essential thing to do before one appears for the aptitude test is to go through the UPSC notification. There are 2 types of questions asked in the interview of the UPSC- a) questions related to current affairs and b) static questions related to the candidate. It is essential to fill up the detailed application form nicely. Also before one appears at the interview, the candidate must practice in front of the mirror.

To do list before the interview:

- Do not react to a passing comment made by the board of interviewer.
- The quality of listening is very important and the candidates should stay calm and composed.
- Do not ever get into an argument with the interviewer and be professional about the interview.
- Treat all the members of the interview board equally.
- Prepare about the city and district you are coming from.
- The board will intersect the candidate's knowledge about current affairs and static issues about him/her.
- Please have enough knowledge about the schemes of the Central and State government schemes related to your state.
- In the DAF do not make your hobbies look flashy.
- Questions will be asked from your graduation subject and also from the optional subject in the mains of the UPSC examination.
- Do not show your extremist ideologies and do not overdo your respect towards the elders.
